

## How to Cite Content in Project MUSE

---

The formats shown here are for citing journal articles and books in the “works cited” or reference list. For more detailed information, consult the *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers*, the *MLA Style Manual and Guide to Scholarly Publishing*, the *Publication Manual of the APA*, or one of the *APA Style Guide* books.

### JOURNAL ARTICLES

#### MLA Style

FORMAT:

Author Last Name, First Name. "Title of Article." *Journal Name* Volume.Issue if applicable (Year): page(s). *Project MUSE*. Web. Day Month Year of access.

EXAMPLE:

Ross, Patricia A. "The Fact Value Dichotomy in Demarcating *Disorder*." *Philosophy, Psychiatry, & Psychology* 14.2 (2007): 107-09. *Project MUSE*. Web. 20 Aug. 2010.

#### APA Style

FORMAT:

Author Last Name, First Name. (Year). Article title. *Journal Name*, volume number(issue number, if applicable), page number(s). Retrieved Month day, year, from Project MUSE database.

EXAMPLE:

Grady, Frank. (2003). Arnoldian Humanism, or Amnesia and Autobiography in the Schwarzenegger Action Film. *Cinema Journal*, 42(2), 41-56. Retrieved September 4, 2004 from Project MUSE database.

### BOOKS

#### MLA Style

FORMAT:

Author Last Name, First Name. *Book title*. Place of publication: Publisher, Publication date. Project MUSE. Web. Day Month Year of access

EXAMPLES:

Treuer, Anton. *Assassination of Hole in the Day*. St. Paul: Borealis-Minnesota Historical Society, 2010. Project MUSE. Web. 18 July 2011.

Conteh-Morgan, John. *New Francophone African and Caribbean Theatres*. African Expressive Cultures. Bloomington, IN: Indiana University Press, 2010. Project MUSE. Web. 18 July 2011.

#### APA Style

FORMAT:

Author Last Name, Initials. (Publication date). *Book title*. Place of publication: Publisher. Retrieved from URL

EXAMPLES:

Weintraub, S. (2011). *Farewell, Victoria!* Greensboro, NC: ELT Press. Retrieved from <http://muse.jhu.edu>

Conteh-Morgan, J. (2010). *New Francophone African and Caribbean Theatres*. African Expressive Cultures. Bloomington, IN: Indiana University Press. Retrieved from <http://muse.jhu.edu>
