Please submit manuscripts of 8,000–10,000 words, inclusive of notes and works cited, in the most recent version of Word and MLA format (*TSLL* uses the *MLA Handbook*, 9th edition). Submissions must be double-spaced in Courier font and 12-point type and should not contain information that reveals the author's identity. Manuscripts should be sent to: TSLL@austin.utexas.edu. Receipt of a manuscript is acknowledged. Decisions take two to four months and require strong recommendations from one to three reviewers and the editors. Please note we will review only one submission per author per year. *TSLL* does not accept notes or book reviews.
