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Francis M. Carroll is Professor Emeritus at the University of Manitoba. His most recent books include *The American Presence in Ulster: A Diplomatic History, 1796–1996* (2005) and *A Good and Wise Measure: The Search for the Canadian-American Boundary, 1783–1842* (2001), the latter of which won the Albert B. Corey Prize and the J.W. Dafoe Prize. He is currently writing a book on the sinking of the passenger liner *Athenia* on the first day of the Second World War while it was sailing from Liverpool to Montreal. Professor Carroll has been the John Adams Fellow at the Institute for United States Studies at the University of London and the Mary Ball Washington Professor of American History at University College Dublin.
