



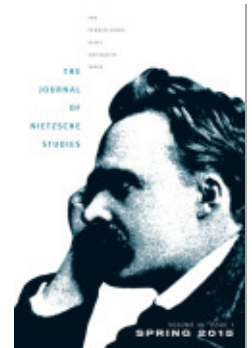

The North American Nietzsche Society is pleased to publish in this issue four papers selected by the Program Committee for presentation in two sessions at the 2012 Central Division Meeting of the American Philosophical Association; as always, these papers were submitted in response to the Society's annual call for papers and were selected by blind editorial review.
