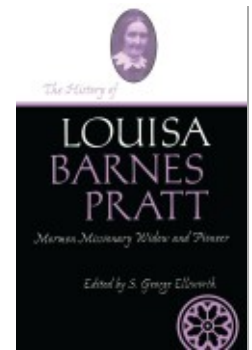

Born: 7 November 1834, Ripley, New York.

Married Jones Dyer, mid-November 1856.

Died: 25 November 1909, Anaheim, California.

Born: 6 March 1837, Ripley, New York.

Married John Hunt, 4 July 1857, San Bernardino, California

Died: 9 March 1885, Snowflake, Arizona.

Louise (Ann Louise, often Ann Louisa, pronounced *Lu-eez*):

Born: 6 April 1840, Pleasant Garden, Indiana.

Married Thomas F. Willis, Beaver, Utah, June 1866.

Died: 1 April 1924?

Ephraim (adopted Polynesian boy):

Born: 20 September 1850, son of Benjamin F. Grouard and Nahina,
Tubuai, French Polynesia.

Adopted by Louisa B. Pratt 8 March 1852. Left home, 1866.
As Frank Grouard: Indian captive, 1869–74; U.S. Army scout, 1874–91.
Died: 15 August 1905, St. Joseph, Missouri.

Caroline Barnes Crosby (Louisa's sister):

Born: 5 January 1807, Warwick, Massachusetts.

Married Jonathan Crosby, 25 October 1834.

Died: 16 February 1884, Beaver, Utah.

Jonathan Crosby (Caroline's husband):

Born: 20 July 1807, Wendell, Massachusetts.

Died: 12 June 1892, Beaver, Utah

Alma (Crosbys' son)

Born: 14 December 1836, Kirtland, Ohio.

Married: Mary Kelly, 21 May 1865.

Died: 14 November 1897, Beaver, Utah.
