INFORMATION FOR CONTRIBUTORS: Previously unpublished articles presenting material of interest to Baroque scholars and performers will be given careful consideration for publication in *BACH*. In general, *BACH* follows *The Chicago Manual of Style*, 16th ed. rev., University of Chicago Press, 2010. All copy must be submitted in PC-compatible format (Word is preferred) or must be printed double spaced on 8½ x 11 paper. Illustrations: musical examples must either be professionally scribed (black ink on white paper) or computer generated (Sibelius preferred). Photographic copies secured from printed music under copyright are unacceptable. Digital or glossy-print photographic copies (5 x 7 or 8 x 10) of early manuscripts, printed pages, city maps, etc., are acceptable when accompanied by title, source, dates of origin, and other bibliographic material, including the names of institutions holding the originals. Such illustrations must be accompanied by permissions to publish from the holding institution.
