Notes for Contributors

Articles submitted to the journal may cover any aspect of Byron Studies; articles on related Romantic or other relevant topics will also be considered. Articles submitted to the journal must not have already been published elsewhere. Essays should be between 5000 and 7000 words long, including notes, and must follow the journal style. Every effort will be made to check the accuracy of information but responsibility for this and for all views expressed lies with contributors. Articles should be addressed to the Editor, Dr Mirka Horová (Charles University, Prague) and submitted as a Word attachment via e-mail (miroslava.horova@ff.cuni.cz). Where permission is needed to reproduce material (e.g. pictures), contributors should ascertain the sources of such permission and whether costs are involved. In most cases these costs will have to be met by the contributor. All articles published in the *Byron Journal* are anonymously peer-reviewed. Copyright remains with the journal and any subsequent reprinting requires the express permission of the Editor.
