Unsolicited manuscripts are welcome, and may be submitted electronically to
biograph@hawaii.edu. They should be double spaced and approximately 2,500 to
10,000 words, including bibliography and end notes. Authors should follow the *MLA
Handbook*, 9th edition.

Biography follows a policy of double-anonymous submission. Authors' names should
not appear anywhere in the submission. Manuscripts should be accompanied by a cover
letter or email containing the author's name and address, and by a brief abstract. Until a
decision is reached, no one involved with the evaluation process will know the identity
of the author. All copyrights of published pieces are held by the George and Marguerite
Simson Biographical Research Center unless other arrangements are agreed upon.
