The journal invites articles that integrate perspectives from social work, psychology, politics, sociology, history, the arts, economics, health care, education, and organizational dynamics. Although the journal focuses primarily on the application and experience of group process and practice, GROUP also publishes relevant research articles.

Continuously published since 1976, GROUP is the journal of the Eastern Group Psychotherapy Society, a regional affiliate of the American Group Psychotherapy Association.
