CORRECTION In the Spring 2022 review for *Never Caught Twice*, the book's author was misquoted on p. 85. The quote should read "[I]f Westerners are going to survive an increasingly multicultural America, they are going to have to shed the conventions and biases of the past while finding new audiences and reasons to be relevant" (267), referring to the Western film genre, not to Westerners as a population.
