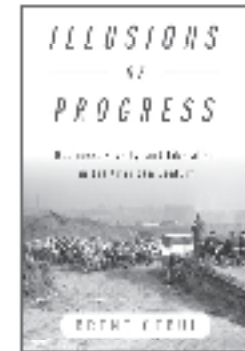

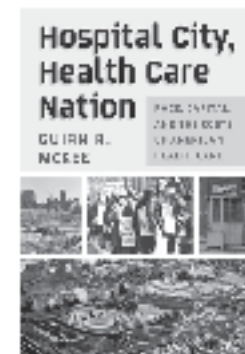

If the author's proposal is of interest to the editorial team, the author will be invited to submit a full article, or a draft if available. Similarly, no unsolicited full review essays will be considered without submitting an initial proposal to the review essay editor.
