The *Journal* is published three times per year: in January, May, and September. Manuscripts on topics related to one or more of the areas identified above should be sent to the Editor by email. Manuscripts should be approximately 15 to 18 (and no longer than 25) double spaced pages. We follow *The Chicago Manual of Style*, and use footnotes instead of endnotes.
